

**EUDORA COMMUNITY LIBRARY  
BOARD MEETING  
Tuesday, April 21, 2026**

Kenny Massey noting a quorum, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

**Public Comments:** None

**Regular Meeting:**

The minutes of the February 17, 2026 meeting and the March 2, 2026 special meeting were discussed. A motion was made to approve the minutes by Amy Jankowski and seconded by Mike Keltner. The motion passed unanimously.

The February Financial Report was discussed. A motion to approve the Financial Report was made by Tim Pringle and seconded by Mike Keltner. The motion was approved unanimously.

The February disbursements were discussed and a motion to approve the disbursements was made by Mike Keltner and seconded by Kenny Massey. The motion passed unanimously.

The January and February Director's report were discussed. A motion to approve the Director's reports was made by Kenny Massey and seconded by Tim Pringle. The motion passed unanimously.

**New Business:**

**Eudora Fire Department Approval:** The Eudora Fire Department did inspect 736 Main and informed the library that it could host special events. The document from the Fire Department has been posted on the library web site. A discussion has had regarding checking the current fire extinguishers in the building to ensure they were fully charged.

**Request to Use 726 Main for Special Event:** Two requests have been made to use 726 Main for special events. The Eudora adult book club has requested to use 726 Main on April 26, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. This is the group that organizes the Trivia night. Kenny Massy made a motion to approve the request which was seconded by Tim Pringle. The motion passed unanimously. The second request was to utilize 726 Main for Trivia Night on November 16, 2026, which is a fundraiser for the Eudora Library. Due to the number of people who attend Trivia night, and concerns about whether the bathrooms were adequate for such a number of people, it was decided to take the request under advisement in order to contact the Eudora Fire Department to determine if such a use is acceptable.

**Floor Plan of 736 Main Street:** Proposed plans for 736 Main renovations ranged from \$610,000.00 to \$1,500,000.00. The major expense would be the bathrooms. It was decided to have Sean Zaudke, the architect, to come speak with the board about the specifics. No further action was taken.

**Meeting with the City of Eudora Code Department and the Fire Department:** After meeting with the City Code and Fire Department representatives the library was advised it did not need a

sprinkler system though a sprinkler system is recommended. Kenny Massey will obtain an estimate from Jayhawk Fire Equipment of Topeka for the cost of installing a sprinkler system. The Library was also advised it will need better ventilation in the north portion of the building.

**His Hands Request to use 726 Main:** His Hands has requested the use 726 Main on Sunday April 26, 2026 for giving away cloths to individuals in need. Kenny Massey made a motion to approve the request which was seconded by Amy Jankowski. The motion passed unanimously.

**Storm Shelter:** The library was advised by its architect the basement of 726 Main does not meet the current definition of a "storm shelter" as defined by building codes. The library will not be able to say the basement is a storm shelter.

**Trustee Training:** Dan Alexander of NEKLS has informed the library that its annual Trustee training will be on Building Safety and Security and is scheduled for September 1, 2026.

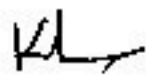
**Old Business:** None
